Entry Terms & Conditions for Ayr Racecourse

1. Trucks / Tractors will be allowed entry into the showground on Friday 10th May from 6.00pm onwards but must be on site by 7.00am on Saturday 11th May.
2. Trucks / Tractors cannot be removed from the showground until Saturday 11th May from 6.00pm onwards.
3. Vehicles must be parked where the stewards direct and should remain parked for the remainder of the event.
4. Only 1 Support Vehicle allowed per truck entered which will be charged at £25 entry fee also.
5. Due to Health & Safety policies NO vehicle movement to take place during show hours.
6. **NO AIRHORNS** allowed at any time, anyone found abusing this rule will be asked to leave the showground.
7. Numbers may be restricted.
8. No trailers allowed.
9. To comply with fire service regulations ALL competitors MUST carry a suitable fire extinguisher in their vehicle.
10. INSURANCE – All vehicles entering the event must carry a minimum of third-party insurance.
11. During Show Hours No Alcohol can be consumed except within licensed areas of the show.
12. No Refunds will be given.

Entry to the showground can be made through Craigie Road 'Gate A' (next to Western House Hotel). When instructed please proceed slowly with your hazard lights on and proceed to your parking position. Parking spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis. There can be no trying to save places for trucks / Tractors coming later as this is neither fair on the trucks / tractors that do make it on time and messes up the final display trying to squash them in gaps that are not big enough. You may however wait until your friends / colleagues arrive and park together.

No tents / gazebos of any sort can be erected or campers / caravans be allowed on the display area overnight.
