Pony riders, Children, Junior and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (Excluding Veteran and Home Pony Teams).

Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m in first round. Must include a double and a treble combination and a water tray.

First TWO horse/rider combinations will qualify, disregarding those already qualified, for the final at the RHS 2018. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Entries will be limited in the final to a maximum of 2 horses per rider and to those riders not competing in any open class of 1.40m or above.

Protests- any protest must be lodged by a person having an interest. The said objection must be lodged in writing with the show Secretary at the show or within SEVEN DAYS of the show and must state specifically the grounds of objection and must be accompanied by a deposit of £100 pounds.

Wearing of Riding Hats - All riders must wear hats that conform to the latest British Standard.

RULE 82.21

No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee

Authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of public are not at risk or injury.

Each Member and exhibitor and member will be issued with tickets for personal use only, entitling entry to the show ground. Tickets and badges are not transferable.
