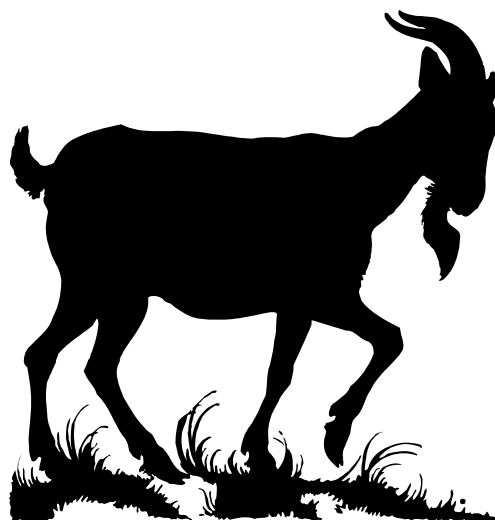

THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY offers a Challenge Certificate for the Best Inspection/Production Goat.

THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY offers a Breed Challenge Certificate for the best goat that has borne a kid of each of the following breeds. Anglo Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, British Alpine, British Guernsey, British Saanen, British Toggenburg and Golden Guernsey.

THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY offers a certificate of Merit for The Best British Milker that has borne a kid / Best British Male over one year old.

THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY offers a challenge certificate for the Best Male Goat over one year old.

THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY offers a Breed Challenge Certificate for the Best Male Goat over one year old of each of the following breeds. Anglo Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, British Alpine, British Guernsey, British Saanen, British Toggenburg and Golden Guernsey.

Note 1: The Goat Classes / Male Classes only / Milking Competitions only are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the entry form. (Also the kidding date for Goats in milk.) All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of the Show.

Note 2: ALL ENTRIES must be accompanied by a CAE negative certificate issued during the previous twelve months and current at the date of the Show or a valid BGS Monitored Herd Certificate.

Note 3: A separate penning area will be available for:
(a) Goats which have had a negative CAE test within 12 months of the Show date. In this case, the dams of kids to comply with the requirement.
(b) Goats from herds in the BGS Monitored Herd Scheme.

Note 4: All goats entered in the milking competitions, udders will be stripped after morning milking on Saturday 12th May 2018.

Note 5: Please note if insufficient entries (3) are forward on the day classes may be combined by Breed Section.

Please Note: Exhibitors are advised that milk produced at Shows should not be fed to goats of any age as this appears to have been a factor in the spread of CAE in the past. Exhibitors are requested not to bring to the Show any Goats that have 'ever' had a positive reaction on a CAE test.

CLASSES:

1. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
2. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the British Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
3. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Toggenburg Section of the Herd Book.
4. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the British Toggenburg Section of the Herd Book.
5. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the British Alpine Section of the Herd Book.
6. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Anglo Nubian Section of the Herd Book.
7. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Golden Guernsey/English Guernsey of The Herd Book.
8. FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, any other variety.
9. VETERAN FEMALE GOAT that has borne a kid, over 6 years, any variety
10. PYGMY ANY AGE

11. SAANEN or BRITISH SAANEN GOATLING that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
12. TOGGENBURG or BRITISH TOGGENBURG that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
13. BRITISH ALPINE GOATLING, that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
14. ANGLO NUBIAN GOATLING that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
15. GOLDEN GUERNSEY/ENGLISH GUERNSEY GOATLING that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
16. ANY OTHER VARIETY GOATLING that has not borne a kid, over one year, but not exceeding two.
17. SAANEN or BRITISH SAANEN KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
18. TOGGENBURG or BRITISH TOGGENBURG KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
19. BRITISH ALPINE KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
20. ANGLO NUBIAN KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
21. GOLDEN GUERNSEY/ENGLISH GUERNSEY KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
22. ANY OTHER VARIETY KID over two months but not exceeding one year.
23. MILKING COMPETITION confined to first kidders.
24. MILKING COMPETITION confined to second and subsequent kidders.

25. MALE KID – All Breeds, over two months but not exceeding one year.
26. BUCKLING MALE - All Breeds, over one year, but not exceeding two.
27. ADULT MALE –Saanen, over one year
28. ADULT MALE – British Saanen, over one year
29. ADULT MALE - Toggenburg, over one year
30. ADULT MALE – British Toggenburg, over one year
31. ADULT MALE – British Alpine, over one year
32. ADULT MALE – Anglo Nubian, over one year
33. ADULT MALE – Any Other Variety, over one year
34. SIRE and PROGENY. Sires do not require to be present, progeny to be shown if Sire is not at the show.
35. YOUNG HANDLERS COMPETITION – up to the age of 7 year old
36. YOUNG HANDLERS COMPETITION – Age 7 to 12 year old
37. YOUNG HANDLERS COMPETITION – Age 12 to 16 year old
