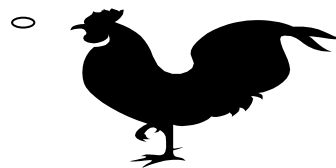
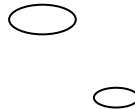
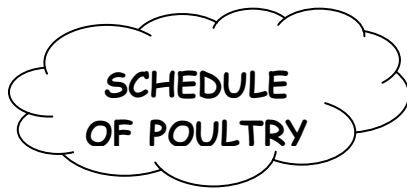

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS & INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS:

1. Competition, except where otherwise stated, is open to all corners.
2. All entry forms must be received on or before **Wednesday 20th April 2016.**
3. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries as they think fit and return entry fees, and to appoint or substitute additional judges, or alter the advertised list of judges as circumstances require.
4. **POULTRY** to be exhibited on SATURDAY 14th May 2016. Exhibits must be delivered on the Friday night after 5pm or on the Saturday morning before 9.15am. No late entries will be accepted. No rail stock will be accepted. Only bedding supplied by the Show will be allowed in the pens. Judging begins at 9.30am on the morning of the Show. **Please note that it will NOT be possible for Poultry to be uplifted from the pens before 4.30pm and the area must be vacated by 5.30pm.**
5. **EGGS** to be exhibited on the Saturday 14th May 2016. **Please note that it will NOT be possible for Eggs to be removed before 4.30pm and the area must be vacated by 5.30pm.**
6. Exhibitors and attendants will only be admitted to the Show on production of an Exhibitors or attendants ticket or on payment of admission fee. The mere production of an admission schedule will not admit the bearer until after the close of the Show. (If more than 8 entries are entered by one person, a free admission ticket is given to the person).
7. The Show will otherwise be subject to the Rules of the Poultry Club.
8. Egg Classes - Plates will be removed by the Association. Exhibitors are not allowed to put their own decoration on these plates.
9. Children of 16 years and under must be present for the presentation, which will take place immediately after the judging.

PLEASE NOTE:

THERE WILL BE A CAR PARKING AREA AVAILABLE TO ALL POULTRY EXHIBITORS IN MAIN CAR PARK, NEXT TO POULTRY TENT. ENTRY TO THE POULTRY TENT WILL BE FROM THIS AREA.
