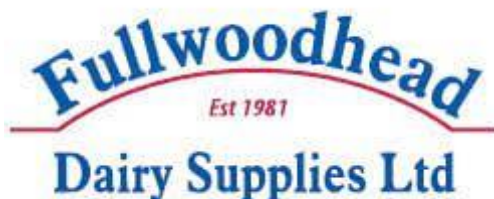

- Note 1:** All cattle (including calves) coming to the Show must come from a herd that is fully accredited free of BVD or they must all be individually tested free of virus (antigen) whether or not they have been vaccinated, in accordance with CHECS rules (www.checs.co.uk)
*****Proof of negative status MUST be received by 6pm on the Wednesday prior to the show or the animals will not be allowed on the field*****
- Note 2:** All Entries in the Cattle Sections must be from herds which are fully accredited within the Brucellosis (Accredited Herds) Scheme.
- Note 3:** Classes may be merged if insufficient entries are received.
- Note 4:** If classes require to be split; this will be done after entry closing date at the Chief Dairy Stewards discretion and prior to catalogues being printed.
- Note 5:** Each Overall Champion qualifies for The Dairy Interbreed.
- Note 6:** Exhibitors are responsible for having their animals in the judging rings on time.
- Note 7:** All Livestock must be paraded at the time stated in the Schedule of the Show (approx. 3.00pm).
