Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

• Newcomers:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2019, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Championship - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to

30th April(subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. 1.10m Open:For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.
