or the animals will not be allowed on the field\*\*\*

- **Note 2:** All Entries in the Cattle Sections must be from herds which are fully accredited within the Brucellosis (Accredited Herds) Scheme.
- **Note 3:** Classes may be merged if insufficient entries are received.
- **Note 4:** If classes require to be split; this will be done after entry closing date at the Chief Dairy Stewards discretion and prior to catalogues being printed.


